



What is YuJa?

YuJa is a video and lecture capture software that can be used through the Canvas and Leo Learning Management Systems, and can be used in the classroom through either a hardware appliance or on a computer with a webcam or other connected video recorder. The YuJa software allows for the prerecording of video, video editing, captioning, quizzing, and the inclusion of other content such as side-by-side PowerPoint slides.

How can faculty access YuJa?

YuJa can be accessed from within courses in Canvas. To add YuJa to your course go to Course Settings, then Navigation, and drag YuJa into the active course navigation.

How is YuJa different from Zoom?

YuJa allows you to pre-record your classes and allows for lecture capture in a classroom. Zoom allows for video conferencing, where faculty and students can meet together in a video or phone conference. YuJa has a **Zoom connector** that automatically stores your Zoom videos in your YuJa account so that you can then embed those videos in your Canvas courses.

What will happen with Kaltura?

Kaltura will be replaced by YuJa in the coming year. All Kaltura videos will be migrated to YuJa and will continue to be available. You should begin to use YuJa instead of Kaltura as soon as you are able, to minimize the amount of video content to be migrated to YuJa.
